

Summer School Attracts Record Enrollment and Results

This year's program broke all records with:

- 552 elementary students taking an average of 2.65 classes each. Performance, cooking and science classes were particularly popular with these students.
- 467 intermediate students taking an average of 2.72 classes each. Students enjoyed a range of topics from robotics to digital photography to song and script-writing to sewing and needle arts.
- 1042 high school students earning more than 6000 credits in a range of classes ranging from social study requirements to electives that are more difficult to get during the school year like art, photography and psychology. Approximately 135 students challenged themselves as they prepared for AP Chemistry in the fall.
